SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY: **3 EVENTS TO TAKE ACTION**

As part of European Mobility Week 2023, which takes place from 16 to 22 September, IMS Luxembourg is organising with partners three awareness-raising and practical events to promote sustainable mobility in Luxembourg: a car-free day on 18 September, bike mobility at Belval on 19 September and a workshop to share best practices on 21 September.

These events aim to raise awareness, start a conversation within companies and between employees, and propose alternatives and best practices to implement concrete actions.

CAR-FREE DAY, 18 SEPTEMBER

To kick off European Mobility Week, several organisations at Cloche d'Or will be holding a 'Car Free Day'. On Monday, 18 September, employees of these organisations will be invited to travel to work by public transport and/or bicycle. This way, the impact of their journeys will be reduced on the day, and new habits may be created. Five organisations are already participating in this initiative: the European Commission, Deloitte Foundation, PwC, Schroeder & Associés and VAUBAN.

CYCLING AT BELVAL, 19 SEPTEMBER

How can I cycle safely? What types of bikes are suitable for me? What could make cycling easier at Belval?

Participants will be invited to try out different types of bikes and will be given plenty of advice on how to get around town safely by bike. They will also discover what the Commune of Sanem and the city of Esch-sur-Alzette offer to encourage active mobility.

The Maison du Cycliste of the ACL, the Municipality of Sanem and the City of Eschsur-Alzette, the asbl Ecotrel, the Minett UNESCO Biosphere, as well as the University of Luxembourg, are the partners of this event. A ChargerCUBE recharging station for electric bicycles offered by Polygone will be presented.

- Meetings and discussions with people involved in promoting cycling in Belval
- Ecobatterien is organising a special battery collection, inviting people to bring in all types of batteries
